PHSCSC Drug, Alcohol, and Tobacco Policy

Portland High School Coed Soccer Club recognizes the benefits to its members, particularly its youth players, of an environment free from the use of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. Optimal performance and full enjoyment of the physical, emotional, and social benefits that soccer offers to youth can only be realized in such an environment; therefore,

It is hereby resolved by the PHSCSC, through its Board of Directors, that its youth player and participants shall be provided to the extent possible with a soccer environment, including games, practices, clinics, tournaments, travel, and related activities and functions, that is alcohol, drug and tobacco free;

It is further resolved that PHSCSC shall endeavor to provide and contribute to a drug, alcohol, and tobacco free environment for its youth participants by developing, supporting, maintaining, and cooperating with programs, policies, activities, and efforts which create a youth soccer environment free from the destructive effects of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco.
